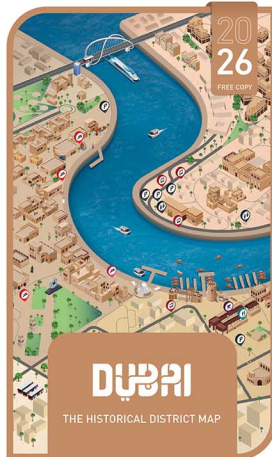

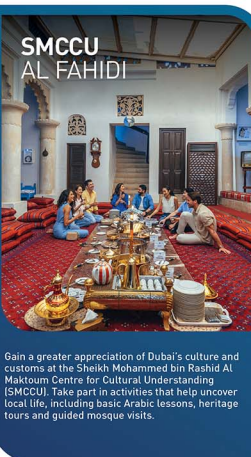

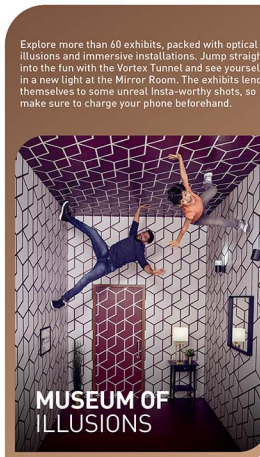


SPICE SOUK

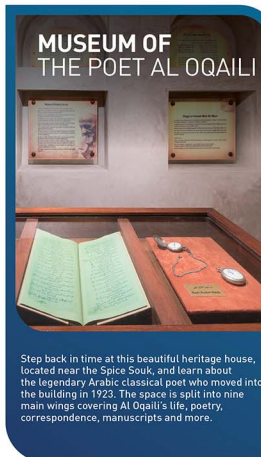


Enjoy an insight into the history of Emirati women – including artists, activists and scholars – and their role in the UAE's development. The museum also hosts regular events including talks, presentations and special exhibitions, and conducts research through its Women's Studies Centre.



MUSEUM OF ILLUSIONS

Explore more than 60 exhibits, packed with optical illusions and immersive installations. Jump straight into the fun with the Vortex Tunnel and see yourself in a new light at the Mirror Room. The exhibits lend themselves to some unreal Insta-worthy shots, so make sure to charge your phone beforehand.



Step back in time at this beautiful heritage house, located near the Spice Souk, and learn about the legendary Arabic classical poet who moved into the building in 1923. The space is split into nine main wings covering Al Qqaili's life, poetry, correspondence, manuscripts and more.



COFFEE MUSEUM

Coffee has always played an important role in Arabic culture, and this museum in Al Fahidi Historical Neighbourhood showcases exactly why. Coffee grinders used in the First World War, historical data dedicated to coffee and old brewing pots are just a few of the artefacts on display. Entry is free, with the museum shop on the ground floor.

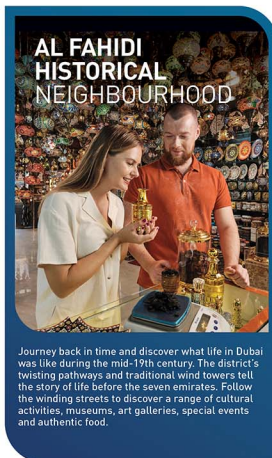

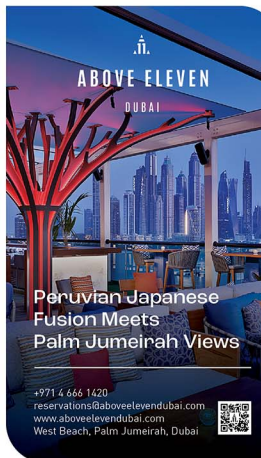

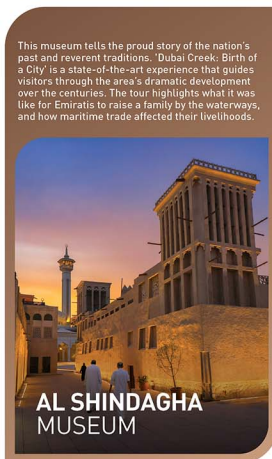

CROSS THE CREEK ON AN ABRA

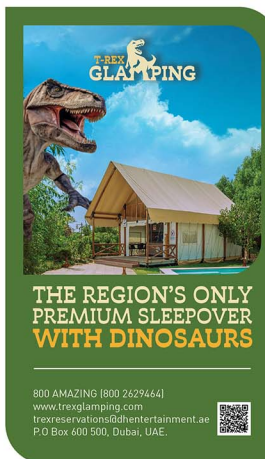
For just AED1 (US\$0.27), you can hop aboard one of Dubai Creek's many traditional ferry boats, known as abras, to travel between Bur Dubai and Deira. Each abra, or 'water taxi', holds about 20 passengers and crossings start around 6am every day. Admire spectacular views of old Dubai on your journey – including traditional houses, wind towers and minarets.

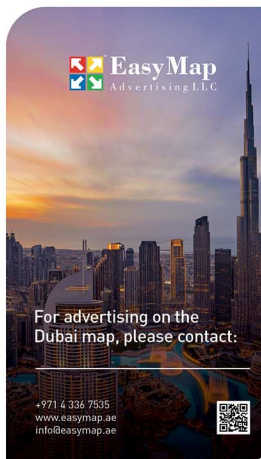

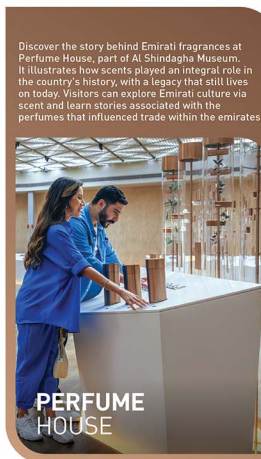
